

# GYFA Meeting Minutes

## 5/20/12

Jeff called the meeting to order at 6:05 p.m.

Jeff spoke first and informed the board that both he and Coach Todd Nagel went to all Gresham-Barlow Middle schools to inform them that GYFA registration is now in full force!

Monique successfully got the information to the district about registration and it will be distributed to the student population.

Jeff noted that we have a firm June 15 deadline for signing up. Anyone who wished to register after that will be put on a waiting list.

We were reminded of the free mini-camp run by GHS coaches and students to be held on Thursday, May 31 and Friday, June 1 from 5:30 - 7:30 p.m.

Greg informed us that he will bring the sample uniform jersey to our next board for approval. The uniform company guarantees 2-week delivery from the date the order is placed. Prices are similar to last year.

Jeff let the board know that Coach Todd Nagel will be taking over as GHS Athletic Director. This means that GHS will be looking for a new head football coach for this upcoming season and going forward.

Greg noted that the dates GYFA need GHS have been secured: June 9 for the rummage sale and July 12-15 for gear handout.

The GYFA by-laws need to be made official...will have final revisions for approval at June 10 board meeting.

Bryan brought up the idea for every board member to wear something that identifies us as such as we attend the games. He will look into jackets and what it would cost us.

Mike noted that all 66 new helmets are in the shed and the 144 reconditioned helmets are ready. Decals will be put on by the coaches on July 12 as they are setting up for gear handout.

Kim Brewster resigned as registrar and Francine brought Nicole Pelster in to become our new registrar. Upon a motion by Becky, and a second motion by Francine, everyone in favor said I and Nicole is now GYFA registrar.

Francine also reminded us that Tammy and Kim needed to be removed from the website and Nicole needed to now be added as the registrar. She also spoke with Tricia from Sports Authority who wanted to give us coupons and such for advertising on our website. Francine will try to meet with her to get the details. The RAZ casino bus is out for now, due to unavailability of buses. Since we can't do this, another option she will work on is setting up a car wash, possibly at Les Schwab. Also, Francine will be getting a GYFA Bottle Drop account setup for cans/bottles.

Becky read over GYFA meeting minutes from April and they were approved. Those minutes will be sent out, along with today's minutes (hopefully this week).
